
THE HEAD

Take the first exit signed to Tiverton (after 5 miles) and at the second roundabout take the B3391 towards Halberton.




When you arrive at Blundell's

Sport Scholarships at Blundell's

Sports Awards are available at 13+ and 16+. Applicants are considered for expertise in any sport, but greater consideration is given to rugby, cricket, hockey and athletics, netball, athletics and tennis.

Awards will be made to those who will make an active contribution to the sporting life of the School. They will be expected to be dedicated to, and to provide leadership in their sport(s). They will have regular Sports Award holders' meetings, strength and conditioning sessions and appraisals, as well as exposure to sports professionals from outside the school. They will have achieved, or be of a standard to achieve, representative honours at County, Regional or National level. It is anticipated that they will be a role model to younger pupils both on and off the 'field'.

VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

Scholarship awards are up to 30% of school fees.

Pupils awarded scholarships may also qualify for means tested bursaries.
